

## **STUDENT WALKER PERMISSION FORM**

Dear Parent or Guardian,

We understand that many of our students walk to and from school. In the best interest of our children's safety, a crossing guard is stationed at the 36<sup>th</sup> Street and Poinsettia Avenue intersection. New Branches Charter Academy allows student to walk home after school <u>with written permission</u> from parents or legal guardians. Students in grades Transitional Kindergarten- fifth grades **WILL NOT BE** allowed to walk home without an approved older sibling or adult.

The procedure for this process is:

- 1. Parent or legal guardian consent (by signing this form, permission is granted)
- 2. Each day, students are dismissed to walk home at 3:10 p.m.
- 3. Walking students with younger siblings will be permitted to pick their siblings up from their homerooms at dismissal time.
- 4. Once students are off campus, they are expected to walk home. If any emergency arises, students will be allowed to walk back to New Branches for support before 6:00 p.m. and enter through the Childcare door (North Entrance) and a parent will be called.
