The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) is a federal law that affords parents the right to access their children's education records, the right to seek to have the records amended, and the right to have some control over the disclosure of personally identifiable information from the educational records. A school may only communicate with the student's parent(s) or legal guardian(s) on any information pertaining to the student's education.
